Langa International has raised a junior debt facility from Eiffel Investment Group to finance the construction of 11 PV projects in Chile, with a total capacity of around 70MW. This portfolio will benefit from stable regulated prices.

Specializing in financing the energy transition, Eiffel Investment Group financed Langa International's projects through the Eiffel Energy Transition and Eiffel Energy Transition II funds, which can provide flexible bridge facilities over short periods. Disbursement will be made in several tranches, one per project once the "ready-to-build" stage has been reached.
